- Notifications for approved grants will be sent out by June 28, 2024.
- Reimbursements will be given out once itemized receipts are received by Mahoning SWCD.
- Projects must be completed by October 30, 2024, to qualify for reimbursement.

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What are Best Management Practices?

Best Management Practices (BMPs) are approaches to water management that protect the natural water cycle from pollution and help achieve healthy water quality. They are effective, economical, enhance public safety and the quality of life for residents and wildlife. BMPs can include shrinking lawns by planting native trees and plants, restoring wetlands by creating rain gardens, installing pervious pavers, and/or installing rain barrels.


What Does the Grant Fund?

This program offers reimbursement funds (up to \$500) to cover design and construction costs for approved BMP projects. Eligible projects include rain gardens, permeable pavement, rain barrels, biofiltration practices, turf reduction, dry wells, conservation scholarships, and other accepted BMPs by Mahoning SWCD.
